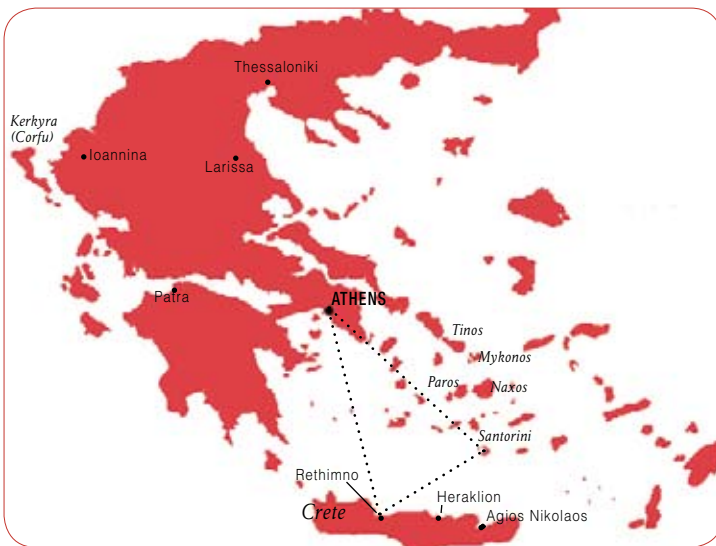

In the evening, follow the guide for a stroll through the narrow labyrinth-like alleys of the old town (Hora) witnessing the charm of the island and its people.

The island’s capital, built on the site of an ancient city, is divided up into four districts: the port, Agios Georgios, the Kastro, and the medieval district, each offering a glimpse into the past of this ancient city.

Continue to Our Holy Virgin of the Dew church (Panagia Drossiani) with its unique wall paintings and miraculous icon—that cries every time the inhabitants of the village are in danger. The journey will evolve through the traditional villages of Filoti and Apiranthos where a coffee break under the shade of the big plane tree or a visit to one of its four museums is mandatory. From there head north to the picturesque fishing village of Apollonas which invites visitors for a memorable lunch in a taverna by the sea. Last but not least, is a visit to the colossal marble statue of Kouros—the representation of male beauty and the power of youth.
